Replying to your letter of January 4th,  
and answering the three questions:

1. I have had only one communication from Greene and that was shortly after his return, giving the explanation as to why he had not called me on the phone, the morning after my brief conversation with him in Halifax. Incidentally, the explanation was satisfactory.

Since then I have written him several letters; endeavoured to contact him by telephone on three different occasions, and have wired him. Have received no response whatever to correspondence and wires, and the telephone report is that he is out of town and will be away for some time, and they cannot advise where I can contact him.

I am beginning to wonder just what he has in mind.

I plan on having my solicitor who drew up my agreement with him, write him Registered mail within the next three or four days. I am just endeavouring to get a little more information from some of the men who operated the drills on the job.

According to our Agreement I have thirty days after December 31st, 1955 to call off the whole matter if I have not been satisfied with the work that has been done.
